Please Note

While many of the materials required for the activities over the 4 days are supplied, you will need to bring your own scissors, cutting mat, Stanley knife, ruler, eraser and any special pens or pencils you enjoy using when doing collage. Glue sticks are not provided, so if this is your preferred form of gluing please add this to your list of what to bring.

If you are rusting paper, you will need your own rubber gloves (ie kitchen type & please write your name on them) and you may also need something to transport your wet papers on in your car (e.g. a plastic sheet or cardboard box).

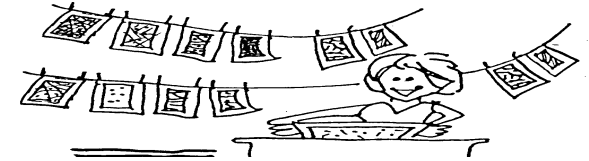
We would also appreciate more used tea bags (dried, emptied and opened, ironing optional) to add to our stash so we don't run out. Heavier paper works best for the sun printing so it would be a good idea to bring watercolour paper which could also be used for the eco dyeing.
